



The City of Doboj has 32,895 ha of arable land, 25,117 of which accounts for plowland and gardens, 3,393 ha are under orchards, 1,268 ha are meadows, and 3,117 ha are pastures.

This area has a long tradition of agricultural production. Although it is the main strategic potential, arable land has a various degree of utilization.

The latest data indicate expansion of cattle production, with 11,217 registered head of cattle, 15,022 pigs, 5,465 sheep, 1,477 goats, and 15,1160 head of poultry. Other things that cannot be disregarded are cow milk production with its 3,615,250 L a year and chicken egg production of 9,763,950 eggs a year.

Doboj has several registered chicken farms, slaughterhouses, feed manufacturers, and there is also production of fruit and vegetables in nurseries.



Agriculture in the City of Doboj



Doboj has **1,630 registered agricultural holdings**, and all of its 67 local city sections are centered around **6 associations of agricultural producers**.

Agriculture in the City of Doboj

Doboj has important **forest resources** rich with game, while its forest fruit and plants are highly regarded because of a clean environment and also demanded as they are food items of organic origin.

Doboj region has conditions for creating a raw base and building of processing capacities for healthy food owing to a favorable geographic position, climate, enough sources of drinking water, and thermal water sources that can be used as an energy source for greenhouse production. In addition, there are considerable areas of uncontaminated arable land, and 69% of the population lives in rural area and is engaged in agriculture.

Beekeeping is one of the prospective agricultural branches because, owing to its natural potentials, it gives products of a very high quality that have already been recognized in the local market.

Agriculture in the City of Doboj



Vegetable growing is both traditional and in greenhouses on the land of up to 0.5 ha. Potato, sweet pepper, cabbage, tomato and cornice cucumber dominate, while onion, carrot, bean, etc. are grown to a lesser extent.

Owing to the soil composition, **fruit growing** is constantly developing. Doboj is particularly known for plum production, including a quality autochthonous cultivar *Osjecanska ranka*. Besides traditional fruit growing, berry fruit and vie growing are also expanding.

Doboj region has large potentials in **horticulture** because of good climate conditions and the length of the vegetation period.
